

Construction within existing buildings. This free-standing solid timber structure was constructed within the historic structure of St Mary's Church in Lambeth, home to the Museum of Garden History. The pre-cut panels were installed into the aisles of the former church and created a series of spaces for exhibition, group activities, shop and cafe.

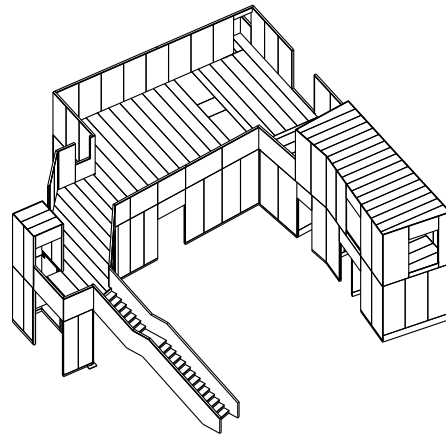

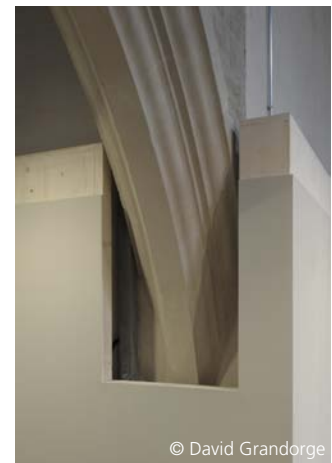
